Explore historic sites and museums across Pennsylvania to get an inside look at the Commonwealth's rich history. With every episode, we highlight the growth of Pennsylvania culture from the history of different colonial immigrant groups, to religious movements, tragedy, and conflict.

July 10

Henry Antes House

Built in 1736, the Henry Antes House is an example of early German colonial architecture and features key artifacts to help visitors experience colonial life.

July 17

Lincoln Highway Heritage Corridor

This museum tells the story of the conception, construction, and eventual life along the nation's first coast-to-coast highway.

July 24

Quecreek Mine Rescue Site

Honoring the miners who were trapped underground from July 24 - 28, 2002, the Quecreek Mine Rescue Site tells the story of their rescue.

July 31

Reading, PA Weekend

Berks History Center

The center highlights the history of Berks County industry from agriculture production to a industrial powerhouse.

August 7

Pittsburgh Tattoo Art Museum

The newly opened museum displays old machines used for tattoos, drawing sheets, and photos of legendary artists.

Stuart Tank Memorial Museum

The Stuart Tank Memorial Museum is dedicated to preserving the history of a Stuart Tank made in Berwick, PA.

Donora Smog Museum

The Donora Smog Museum showcases the tragedy that jumpstarted national environmental and public health movements

September 4

Springs Historical Society

The museum showcases a rich collection of folklife items such as looms, spinning wheels, and textiles.

Saegertown Historical Society

Learn what life on the Western Pennsylvania frontier was like at the Saegertown Historical Society's McGill House.
